CROWN & BRIDGE

After your appointment for crown and bridge treatment, a temporary crown is placed on the tooth or teeth involved. The temporary crown(s) protects the teeth while the custom crown or bridge is being fabricated. Temporary cement is used so that the crown can easily be removed at your next appointment.

If your temporary crown comes off before your next appointment, place the temporary crown back on your tooth with a dab of toothpaste or denture adhesive and call our office for an appointment to have it re-cemented.

With your temporary crown and with your permanent, you may experience some discomfort due to the irritation of the area during the treatment procedures. You may also notice sensitivity to cold or pressure.

Your new permanent crown will be shaped and shaded especially to your teeth in color and fit. After your new permanent crown is in place you may need a few days to adjust to it. If you feel the bite is not correctly balanced, please call for an appointment and we will adjust it.

Care for your new crown with proper brushing and flossing. It is especially important to keep the edge of the crown clean at the gumline.
